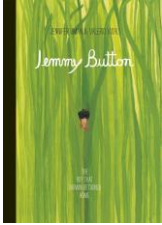

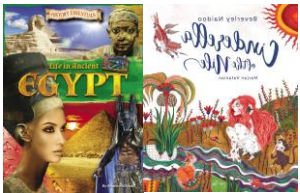
Writing

We will begin the half term by completing our Return Narrative based on the book 'Jemmy Button' by Jennifer Uman and Valerio Vidali. We will then be writing a letter in the mind-set of Jemmy Button.



Reading

In Shared reading, we will share and discuss a range of Non-fiction texts with an Egyptian theme. We will use them to explore text features and further develop our reading skills.



Science

This term in Science, we will explore Animals including Humans (Nutrition). We will recap our prior knowledge on what an animal needs to survive and why exercise is important. Also, we will be looking at the how muscles work together to allow movement, what are the role of muscles and how do they work in pairs with bones, the role of the different nutrients and how they keep the body healthy, what are the three main jobs of the skeleton and how animals get the nutrients they need.



Geography

Our Geography work for this half term is a comparison study between Europe and Greece. We will be locating Greece on a World map and a map of Europe, what is Europe and how many countries make up the continent, know what countries are located in the different regions and also locating the city of Athens on a map of Greece. Also, we will be identifying the geographical features of Europe.

Maths

We will begin the half term by completing our work on multiplication and division. We will use grid methods, known facts, scaling and formal written methods. We will then move on to fractions, where we will learn unit and non-unit fractions, equivalent fractions, comparing fractions and fractions on a number line. We will use manipulatives to help.

RE & PSHE

Our RE lessons this half term will be Hinduism, we will be exploring the roles and responsibilities of Dharma, the duties than Hindu's believe in.

Computing

PE

In PE, the children will be utilising the swimming pool and cricket. In swimming, the children will be building their confidence and learning the front crawl and backstroke. In cricket, they will be learning the fielding skills such as throwing, passing and catching. They will then move onto establishing the correct handling of the cricket bat.
